

How to Sign into O'Reilly's Safari Books Online



Important Note: Not all Students/Faculty members will have access to O'Reilly's Safari Books Online unless you are instructed by your Program/Department to have an account with O'Reilly.

1. Visit Safari Books Online login page directly at <https://www.safaribooksonline.com/accounts/login/>

2. In the email address field, please **type** in your LAFS email address (@lafilm.edu) and press **enter** or **click "Sign In with Single Sign On."**

Leave the password field blank, (in fact, it should disappear after you enter your email address or click out of the textbox).


3. This will recognize that you are part of LA Film School and it will send you to the LA Film School login page.

Once you are at the LA Film School Login page, please **type** your LAFS credentials and **click "Sign In."**

- You will be authenticated through the LA Film system and you will be sent over to the Safari Books Online site. This should take just a few moments after you enter your LAFS credentials.
